

**Ordinance No. 134-6**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 134  
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO BOATING**

PURPOSE: Chapter 134 regulates boating upon the waters of Lake Sinissippi in the Village of Hustisford and the Village channel and prescribes penalties for violations of this Code. The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resources.

The Village Board of the Village of Hustisford, Dodge County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The definition of “motor boat” shall be deleted from the Village Code Section 134-1.

SECTION 2: Section 134-2, Adoption of State Statutes, is created to read as follows:

134-2 State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted. State boating laws found in Sections 30.50 to 30.71 & 30.77 Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

SECTION 3: Section 134-3 is amended by adding subsection (k): (k) no person shall operate a boat faster than “slow-no-wake” in the waters of Lake Sinissippi when the water level exceeds elevation 100.00 on the gauge at the Hustisford Dam—14.4 inches above spilling crest of the dam, as based on the bench mark. This “slow-no-wake” restriction will be posted at all public access points when in effect. This slow-no-wake restriction will be removed when the water level is below 99.90 (13.2 inches of water above spillway crest of dam) for a period of three consecutive days, unless hazardous conditions exist. Following cessation of hazardous conditions, the slow-no-wake restriction will be removed.

The Village of Hustisford or Designee shall place and maintain a synopsis of this “slow-no-wake” restriction at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Village of Hustisford pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

SECTION 4: Penalties. Violations of Chapter 134, as amended herein, shall be subject to the penalties upon conviction as set forth in Chapter 1, sections 1 through 3 of this Code.

SECTION 5: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
