

Police and License Committee of the Village of Hustisford

Meeting Minutes August 29, 2016

Opening: The regular meeting of the Police and License Committee of the Village of Hustisford was called to order at 4:30 p.m. on August 29, 2016 in the Hustisford Village Hall by Committee Chairman Ted Engelbart

Present:

1.) Public Appearances: None

2.) Approval of Minutes from the July 25, 2016 meeting: A motion was made to approve the minutes by Dennis Uecker and seconded by Mike Grant. The motion carried.

3.) Chief Link briefed the committee on the departments 2015 goals & objectives. Chief Link informed the committee that the National Night Out event was very well attended and it appears to be growing each year. Officer Roeber represented the police department at the high school and he was very well received. Chief Link stated that both of these community service projects were largely successful

The Circus at Neider Park and the Lions Venetian Night events were run very smoothly with no disturbances, no traffic problems, nor any complaints.

Chief Link further informed the committee that the Suburban Mutual Aid Response Team (GET SMART) was signed by the Police Chiefs at the DCELEA meeting on August 3, 2016.

Chief Link had upgraded his department cellular telephone plan which is actually less expensive and more inclusive than the previous plan.

The TRACS is fully operational at the desktop and in the new squad.

Chief Link also stated that most of his projected goals for 2016 have been accomplished and he will be starting work on the departments website.

Chief Link further informed the committee that August 15, 2016 was his 39-year anniversary in law enforcement and August 28, 2016 would be his 8-year anniversary as the Hustisford Police Chief. The committee members congratulated Chief Link on these accomplishments and for his service to the community.

4.) Discussed operator's license for Brook Scherg-Hetchler. Upon the recommendation of Chief Link, Ted Engelbart made a motion to refer the approval of the license to the full board, Mary Jensen 2nd the motion and the motion carried.
