

Police and License Committee of the Village of Hustisford

Meeting Minutes Monday, December 16, 2019

Opening: The regular meeting of the Police and License Committee of the Village of Hustisford was called to order on Monday, December 16, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. in the Hustisford Village Hall by Committee Chairman Ted Engelbart

1. Call to order:

2. Public appearances: Kirk Kaul

3. Approval of minutes from the November 25, 2019 meeting: A motion was made to approve the minutes by Mary and seconded by Dave. The motion carried.

4. Chief Link briefed the committee on the departments 2019 goals & objectives: Officer Rynearson participated in the annual Shop with Cops in Dodge County which was a huge success. Chief Link also provided an update on the municipal court/state debt collections which showed that the total intake through November was \$7393.37

5. Discuss/recommend operator licenses for Joseph Schiller and Ronda K Cowlshaw. Chief Link did the vetting of both Schiller and Cowlshaw and recommended approval. Mary made a motion to forward to the full board for their approval, Ted second and the motion carried.

6. Discuss school information with the committee to produce a letter for the township for support of the SRO position in the future. Chief Link stated that 399 students were enrolled in the school, 215 students between the village and the town, 123 students from Hubbard and the rest from various communities. A letter will be forward to the Town of Hustisford, Hubbard and the other communities in May regarding the contribution of their fare share in the funding of the SRO.

7. Discuss the language for permit parking on Lake Street. Chief Link did extensive research of the other communities and found that none of the them grant permits to park on their main street. Chief Link recommend the continuation of the present parking restrictions with officer discretion. Mr. Kirk Kaul expressed his understanding and agreement with Chief Links recommendation.

8. Schedule next Police and License Committee. The next Police and License Committee meeting will be conducted on Monday, January 20, 2020 at 9:00am.
