

## Police and License Committee of the Village of Hustisford

Meeting Minutes  
Friday, March 10, 2023

Opening: The regular meeting of the Police and License Committee of the Village of Hustisford was called to order on Monday, March 10, 2023 at 7:30 a.m. in the Hustisford Village Hall by Committee Chairman Ted Engelbart

1. Call to order:

2. Discuss/approve minutes from 1/25/2023. Andy made a motion to approve the minutes, which was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave and passed unanimously.

3. Chief Kaepernick to give the committee an update on the police department goals and community projects. Chief Kaepernick informed the committee that he had attended the Police of Chief's conference. Also, that he received a letter from Rep Scott Fitzgerald commending Officer Jacob Berner, who received the departments Life Saving Award. Also, that Officer Kruger had rendered his resignation from the department effective 2/10/2023. The chief further said that Roy Jaster declined the salvage vehicle position with the department. The chief has posted a hiring article since 2/15/2023 and to this date no qualified individuals applied. The winter parking ordinance was enforced resulting in 25 citations the first time and then 14 citations and down to 4 citations.

4. Presentation/approval of 2022 Annual Report. The annual report was reviewed by the committee and a motion made by Andy to approve the report and recommend approval by the full board, was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave and passed unanimously. Chief Kaepernick will also post the 2023 annual report to the website.

5. Discuss/recommend possibility of creating a full-time officer position for the Hustisford Police Department. Andy recommended tabling this issue until after the spring election, was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave and passed unanimously.

6. Discuss/recommend operators licenses for Tenika Johnson, James Schwartz, Nancy Wood, JoAnn Erickson, Brianna Boeck and Gerald Sherman. Chief Kaepernick informed the committee that he conducted background checks on all the individuals and was recommending approval. Andy made a motion to approve and forward the recommendation to the full board for their approval, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave and passed unanimously.

7. Schedule next police committee meeting. The next meeting is pending.

8. Adjourn. A motion was made by Andy to adjourn, was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave and passed unanimously.
